

Extension of Temporary Change to the Calculation of Patient Encounters in the Continuity of Care Clinic Review Committee for Osteopathic Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine

The Review Committee for Osteopathic Neuromusculoskeletal Medicine has extended the temporary changes to the calculation of continuity of care clinic patient encounters in the ACGME Case Log System that were first put in place in 2021. All patient encounters supervised by a board-certified or board-eligible neuromusculoskeletal medicine specialist that are logged in the ACGME Case Log System will be included in the continuity of care clinic patient encounter calculation. The temporary changes will be in place through at least the 2023-2024 academic year. The Review Committee will annually provide an update on this extension during the ACGME Annual Educational Conference specialty update session and through the ACGME's e-Communication.
